

MCSO CITIZEN PATROL SELF-QUIZ

Applicants must pass a 50-question multiple choice exam with a score of 80% (40 out of 50 correct answers). Below are some sample questions.

- 1) Citizen Patrol members are encouraged to:
 - A) Observe, detect, and report suspicious activities
 - B) Contact suspicious subjects for identification purposes
 - C) Conduct solo foot patrols to increase visibility in an area
 - D) Direct traffic flow in heavily congested parking lots

- 2) If a citizen flags you down for directions, you should:
 - A) Call the non-emergency number: 503-823-3333 and ask for the district deputy
 - B) Call the Citizen Patrol liaison deputy: 503-251-2502
 - C) Assist the person with your issued map or prior knowledge of the area
 - D) Let them in your vehicle and drive them to the location if it's within 2 miles or less

- 3) If you encounter an irate person, you should:
 - A) Maintain a safe distance while you or your partner calls 911 or the non-emergency#
 - B) Use a firm, strong voice while using your cell phone to video the subject as evidence
 - C) Warn the person that they may be arrested by a deputy for disorderly conduct
 - D) Move away from your partner to prevent them from being a target

- 4) Citizen Patrol members may:
 - A) Carry a concealed weapon ONLY if they have a concealed weapons license (CHL)
 - B) Carry a concealed weapon only if the liaison deputy is informed they have a CHL
 - C) Never carry a concealed weapon while on patrol
 - D) A and B only

- 5) If a State Parks or Corbett School employee contacts you about conducting extra patrols on a particular date and time, you should:

 - B) Give them the contact information for the liaison deputy
 - C) Contact the liaison deputy with the patrol request
 - D) B and C only
